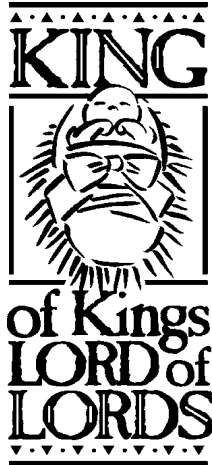

The King is Coming Soon!

Opening Welcome & Prayer:

Hymn:..... *TLH 68: The Advent of Our King*

1. The advent of our King
Our prayers must now employ,
And we must hymns of welcome sing
In strains of holy joy.
2. The everlasting Son
Incarnate deigns to be;
Himself a servant's form puts on
To set His servants free.
3. O Zion's Daughter, rise
To meet thy lowly King,
Nor let thy faithless heart despise
The peace He comes to bring.

Opening Response:

P: Arise, sons of the Kingdom!

C: The King is drawing nigh;

P: Arise, and hail with gladness

C: The Ruler from on high.

P: Ye Christians, hasten forth!

C: Your praise and homage bring Him

P: And glad hosannas sing Him;

C: Naught else your love is worth.

1st Reading:.....*2 Samuel 7:8,12-16*

The Lord promises that a King will come from David's lineage and will rule His kingdom forever.

Hymn:..... *TLH 59: Hail to the Lord's Anointed*

1. Hail to the Lord's Anointed,
Great David's greater Son!
Hail, in the time appointed,
His reign on earth begun!
He comes to break oppression,
To set the captive free,
To take away transgression,
And rule in equity.
5. Kings shall bow down before Him
And gold and incense bring;
All nations shall adore Him,
His praise all peoples sing;
To Him shall prayer unceasing
And daily vows ascend,
His kingdom still increasing,
A kingdom without end.

2nd Reading:.....*Psalm 2:1-8*

Although despised, the Lord's anointed King will overcome.

Choir:..... *Come, Thou Long Expected Jesus*

3rd Reading:.....*Micah 5:2-5a*

Out of little Bethlehem will come the long-anticipated King.

Hymn:..... *TLH 103: To Shepherds as They Watched*

2. At Bethlehem, in David's town,
As Micah did of old make known;
'Tis Jesus Christ, your Lord and King,
Who doth to all salvation bring.
3. Oh, then rejoice that through His Son
God is with sinners now at one;
Made like yourselves of flesh and blood,
Your brother is the eternal God.
4. What harm can sin and death then do?
The true God now abides with you.
Let hell and Satan rage and chafe,
Christ is your Brother--ye are safe.

4th Reading:.....*Isaiah 9:2,6-7*

A Child will be born as King to establish spiritual peace.

Hymn:... *TLH 106: The People that in Darkness Sat*

1. The people that in darkness sat
A glorious light have seen;
The light has shined on them who long
In shades of death have been. ... {repeat}
5. His name shall be the Prince of Peace,
The Everlasting Lord,
The Wonderful, the Counselor.
The God by all adored. ... {repeat}
6. His righteous government and power
Shall over all extend;
On judgment and on justice based,
His reign shall have no end. ... {repeat}

5th Reading:.....*Luke 1:26-33*

The King's arrival is announced to His mother.

Hymn:..... *TLH 645: Behold, a Branch is Growing*

2. Isaiah hath foretold It
In words of promise sure,
And Mary's arms enfold It,
A virgin meek and pure.
Through God's eternal will
This Child to her is given
At midnight calm and still.
5. O Savior, Child of Mary,
Who felt our human woe;
Savior, King of Glory.
Who dost our weakness know,
Bring us at length, we pray.
To the bright courts of heaven
And to the endless day.

6th Reading:.....*Psalm 24:8-10*

The gates of our hearts are to prepare for our King's arrival.

CDS Children:..... *Light the Candle*

The Lighting of the Candles:..... *Organ Interlude*

Note: You may light your candle by tipping it to another lighted candle, but please do not tip a lighted candle. We ask that only children ages 5 and older hold their own candles.

7th Reading.....*Luke 2:1-11*

The King long-expected is born.

Note: After singing the first stanza of Silent Night, please sing "oo" for two stanzas during the reading. Afterward the congregation may then again join in singing stanza 3:

**1. Silent night! Holy night!
All is calm, all is bright,
Round yon Virgin Mother and Child.
Holy Infant, so tender and mild,
Sleep in heavenly peace,
Sleep in heavenly peace.**

NOTE: TWO STANZAS OF "oo"

**3. Silent night! Holy night!
Son of God, love's pure light
Radiant beams from Thy holy face,
With the dawn of redeeming grace,
Jesus, Lord, at Thy birth,
Jesus, Lord, at Thy birth.**

Freely ransomed by Thy grace.

Hymn:.....*TLH 87: Joy to the World*

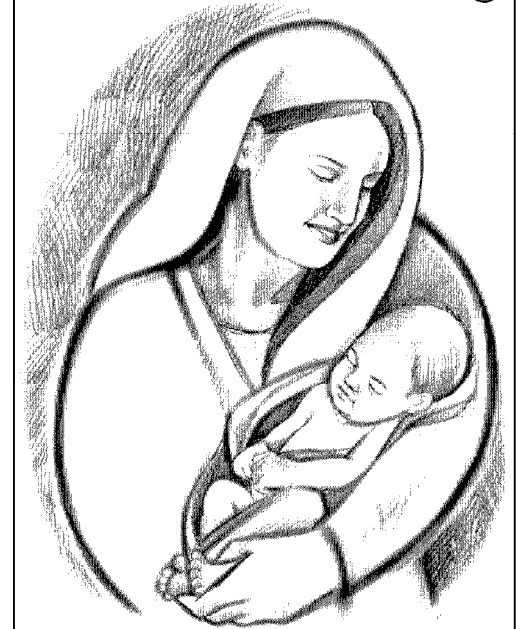
1. Joy to the world, the Lord is come!
