Meeting called to order with prayer at 11:39 a.m. Roll call: 20 present, 4 excused, 13 absent. Minutes of the July Voters meeting were read and approved as presented.

Treasure's report was approved as presented. A dip in giving was noted, which correlated with a dip in average attendance – 90 per service. Year to date, the budget is a little behind.

Alvin Jask was ratified as a communicant member. Alvin Jask's membership as a voter was then moved and accepted.

### Pastor's Report

- Malena Rose Duehlmeier baptism was reported.
- Motion to accept the membership by transfer of Seth Sorensen from Our Savior's in Jamestown, ND, and Kate Sorenson from Gift of God in Mapleton, ND, was accepted pending the receipt of transfer.
- Jonathan Davis repented of the sin of an extramarital relationship after a meeting with Pastor Hein and Elder Al Rosendahl. Pastor reported having just received Jonathan's letter of repentance.
- Motion made and approved to remove from membership Sonja and Merton Bettendorf due to inactivity.
- Troy Welker is now a member of an LCMS church. Motion was made and approved to accept his oral request to be removed from membership.
- Julie Brandt and Christopher Fleming have completed their marital instruction.
- Many other membership issues continue to be worked on by Pastor and the Board of Elders.
- David Pfeiffer was here 6 weeks as a Vicar, and all went well.
- A letter from President David Schierenbeck to the Eden Prairie Preaching Station was summarized.
  - Reported that the Metro Outreach Fund balance of \$13,000 is close to the initial \$15,000.
  - Listed 3 options that will be presented to the group:
    - 1) Continue the work as we now are;
    - 2) Ask the Mission Board to consider a Mission there to help fund a worker;
    - 3) Reduce the worship service schedule to 2 per month.Discussion of the 3 options followed
- There will be a Reformation Service at Mankato October 31.
- VBS attendance was 23.
