David: As we gaze upon the skies on a clear night many stars can be seen. Where did they come from? We learn about this in the Bible. Our confident conclusion is that our Triune God Himself — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — made them on one of the six days of creation. Listen to what Scripture says about the creation of the stars.

Patrick: Then [on the fourth day] God said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens ..."; and it was so. Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. Genesis 1:14-16

Victoria: Lift up your eyes on high, And see who has created these things. Who brings out their host by number; He calls them all by name, By the greatness of His might And the strength of His power; Not one is missing. Isaiah 40:26



3. The Star 9s Born &

Brooke: At the right time God sent forth His Son, Jesus Christ, to be the Star of Jacob. His birth was one which was unique. He was born to die. As we ponder the starry night of Jesus birth, let us remember that Jesus was born to die for the sins of all people, people who number even more than the shining stars above.

Children: Luke 2:1-7

(1) And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. (2) (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) (3) And all went to be taxed, everyone into his own city. (4) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) (5) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. (6) And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. (7) And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes, and laid Him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.
