Meeting opened with prayer. July Council meeting minutes read and approved. July Treasurer's report presented and approved.

- With the upcoming start of Sunday School and Bible Class, are there going to be issues accommodating expected increases in attendance? Some discussion on having 2 services and traffic flow.

#### **Board of Education Report**

- The school workday went well.
- One family has decided that they now will homeschool their 2 children this
  year. There have been discussions with other families who are interested in
  sending their children. With these new students, enrollment could be up to
  12 for the lower grades and 15 for the upper grades.
- Work is being done on a procedure for how to handle a case of a student becoming sick. Decision was made to leave it up to the teachers' discretion to cancel school the following day.
- There is a request to put a projector in the lower grade classroom. The budget doesn't really allow for the purchase of one. Some discussion on if it would be OK to go ahead with the purchase. The consensus was to get the projector.

#### **Board of Trustees Report**

- Work continues on fire related items (cleaning, repair, insurance claims).
- Motion approved a gift of a matching bookcase for the Fellowship Hall from Duane Enns.
- The internet connection has been restored. Significant upgrades were made in the process (changing the source to be solely from the SE corner, replacing the line indoors, etc.).
- Pat is working on getting new numbers/letters for the sign which were damaged in the fire.
- Some of the vacuums are not working very well and need to be checked.
