



# Council Meeting Notes - March 13, 2022

Meeting opened with prayer. February Council meeting minutes read and approved. Treasurer's report was reviewed and approved. Tuition aid was dispersed, \$3,900 for 2 students. Organ fund is in need of \$5-6,000 more.

#### Pastor's Report

- Ryan Oman resigned from his position on the Board of Education. He also requested that he be removed from voting membership. He disagrees with wording in the church constitution pertaining to notifying pastor of meetings.
- Given Rick Gram's deteriorating health, Gloria agrees that Rick's voter membership should be discontinued.
- Pastor has been meeting with Dan Kelley for instruction class. Dan's stepmother recently passed given that she was struck by a truck.
- Norma Rust's committal service will be on Mon., March 28 in South Dakota.
- Pulpit rotation without Red Wing for the Wed. evening Lenten services.
- Some of the technology (projector & mics) have had issues lately. Work being done to resolve. Some discussion live streaming of Grace's services.

#### **Board of Elders Report**

• Easter breakfast is coming up. Looking for volunteers to help.

#### **Board of Education Report**

- Might need to modify the constitution regarding the principal. The current situation is that 2 teachers are serving as co-principals while the constitution can be interpreted as Pastor is the principal. Some discussion followed. Suggestion to have the constitution committee investigate.
- Of the non-member families who have inquired about Grace, most of them are lower-grade students. The board would like to swap the north and south classrooms, allowing Mrs. Nelson's room to accommodate more students.

#### **Board of Trustees Report**

- Recommendation to move the June workday to July.
- The yearly financial audit was done. Everything is in good order although one item was noted. The Sunday School offerings are sent to Kinship which is a CLC fund but are listed in the offering counting program as one of the Grace funds. Phil will make a change to fix the issue.
- Some consideration given to having direct deposit for paychecks. Each transaction would require a processing fee.
- Plans are to replace some of the light fixtures by the school entry.

#### Other Business

• New Organ: Barry Hay will visit prior to the delivery for final arrangements. The current organ platform will need to be rebuilt. Options for the speaker cutouts will be explored; could be covered by speaker cloth or pipes. An organ dedication service should be considered. Decorative side panels were ordered (~\$1000). Routing of speaker wires through the Narthex ceiling to the Parents' Room and then to a duct along the East wall is an option.
