There was a question about the copier maintenance. Pastor and others think that there was an agreement that free service would be provided based on purchase of toner cartridges from the service company. The treasurer will check into this.

Other Business

- Rick Nelson is planning to get the sanctuary project going again. He is considering setting up a table in the narthex with display of plans and samples for a couple of months. The committee would like to start work on the sanctuary this summer.

- Benno Sydow and Phil Radichel reviewed the 2022 offering envelope usage.
 There were 80 envelopes assigned, 50 were used, 26 not used (13 of the 26 were recent confirmands and 13 were to families).
- There was encouragement to work with non-attending members.
- Grace has previously expressed interest in getting 300 of the new hymnals that
 Messiah Eau Claire is planning to produce when they are ready. A proposal
 relating to this hymnal would be brought to the council before actual purchase.
