OUR SYMPATHETIC HIGH PRIEST

It is important that your pastor be a humble man. He's just like every other Christian-a sinner in need of God's grace. It's a sad situation when a pastor acts holier-thanthou and standoffish as though he didn't need the Gospel he is preaching. Imagine your pastor not feeling the need to join in the confession of sins during a worship service. Such a man would be delusional and of little help to the congregation.



No matter who your pastor is, thank God you always have a sympathetic high priest in heaven. Think about what it means that Jesus can sympathize with your weakness. He isn't merely aware that you face temptations. He doesn't go about His high priestly duties grumbling about having to work with such weaklings. No, He actually knows what it's like for us! He shared our weakness. In His state of humiliation, the Son of God was prey to every kind of temptation from the devil just like you and me. Whatever sins you have confessed today, Jesus was tempted to commit the same ones.

Yet Jesus was without sin. There's the vital difference. Though tempted to do everything God forbids, He never trespassed. Though tempted to leave some of God's will undone, He completely fulfilled the law and gave His life as the once and for all atonement for all our sins and failings.

Now He is our sympathetic Mediator. There is no problem or issue we can bring to Him that He has not dealt with before. He will never be too shocked or horrified to do His priestly work of absolving you of your sins. In every temptation and trial go to Jesus. He knows. He's been there. He will be your strength in your weakness.
