Meeting opened with prayer. October Voters' meeting minutes read and approved. 4th quarter Treasurer's Report presented and approved. 2025-Year-End presented and approved.

Pastor's Report

- Max Milbrandt has 5 or 6 lessons left. Pastor Hein is planning to complete that instruction.
- Daniel Hein is helpfully serving the role of assistant to the pastor created in December.
- Pastor Hein's Google Drive he has used for Grace documents will need some update to make it current. Pastor will work on those updates and will be working on the yearbook.
- Pastor Hein is willing to help as he is able after his retirement.
- Logan Keller, his wife, Morgan and their daughter Mabel have been attending Grace recently. Motion approved to accept Morgan Keller and her daughter Mabel into membership at Grace pending receipt of transfer from Messiah in Eau Claire, WI.
- Pastor Hein presented his report of highlights from his 2025 Minististrations at Grace.
- Service and Bible class online hours watched has increased, along with church website usage.
- Motion approved to grant Pastor Hein a peaceful release from his call at Grace.
- Elders deferred their report to the other business section of the meeting.

Board of Education Report

- Kevin led the Voters in the singing of the common doxology in thanks to our LORD.
- Motion approved to keep the non-member day school tuition at its current level in 2026-27.
- Bonnie Baker and Kyle Aymond are planning for the 50th anniversary of the Grace school to be celebrated on September 13, 2026.

Board of Trustees' Report

- The water fountain has been installed and is working well.
- Per request of the Council, the plowing company has added the parsonage sidewalks to their contract. Concern about the reduced plowed parking lot area caused by the snow buildup.

Other Business

- Rick has asked a woodworker to help design an alternative for the altar.
- Motion approved to submit \$75,000 as the Grace CBP estimate for 2026.
- Motion to approve the Investment policy as written was supported. Discussion about this policy document focused on the scope of the document and concern about investment risk. Motion carried to table the investment document motion to the next Voters meeting.
- A farewell service for Pastor Hein is planned to be held on Feb. 1.
- The February communion service will be deferred from Feb. 1 to Feb. 8.
- Dale reported that Grace is in compliance with the Minnesota Paid Family and Medical Leave (PFML) Act. Our taxable wage base for 2026 is \$185000. The 2026 premium would be about \$1620.
- There is an anticipated need for housing assistance for Janelle. Dale asked the Voters to consider a monthly housing allowance, providing a rented apartment, or purchasing and providing a house. There was discussion concerning the cost and teacher equity. It was pointed out that Grace does not have a policy concerning teacher housing and that other CLC congregations have various policies on this topic. Pastor Hein said that the Hein family preference was that if housing assistance were to be provided for Janelle, their preference would be for a monthly allowance.
- Dale explained the next steps in the call process.

New business

- Benno explained that the identification of hospitality teams will change in order to avoid confusion with Dorcas Guild committees.

A motion to recess the meeting was supported and approved by unanimous vote.
