Brief Biography: With TLH 648: I Am Jesus' Little Lamb

Jenettie Evlyn Miesen was given life by her Creator on May 29, 1924, in Bowdle, SD, the daughter of Fred and Frieda Rieger. She was given spiritual life and became a Child of God through the gift of Holy Baptism soon after at St. John's Lutheran Church in Bowdle. She received the precious gift of the Lord's life giving body and blood following confirmation. Jenettie graduated from Bowdle High School and then Northern State Teachers College in Aberdeen, SD. Galatians 3:26-27: "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ."

Jenettie was united in marriage to Richard C. Miesen on June 14, 1959, in Bowdle. The LORD blessed their marital union with Christian companionship and with two children: Curt and Dale. **Psalm 128:3-4:** "Your wife *shall be* like a fruitful vine in the very heart of your house, your children like olive plants all around your table. Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the LORD."

During her life, Jenettie served as an elementary teacher and was the Director of Meals on Wheels in North Canton, OH, and, upon moving to Minnesota, was a volunteer for 30 years at the Methodist Hospital in St. Louis Park, MN. She spent many years living in Plymouth, MN, and for the last years of her life she was a resident at The Wellstead of Rogers, MN. She enjoyed her family, bowling, and therapeutic swimming.

Through the inspired Word of God and work of the Holy Spirit, Jenettie was committed to its truth and understood by faith the payment her Savior made for her sins, living her life in thanksgiving to Him. She was steadfast in her confession of Christian faith, being an active member for many years at Grace Lutheran Church in Fridley, MN. **Ephesians 1:13-14** "In [Christ] you also *trusted*, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory."
