


Brief Biography: With WS 785: Children of the Heavenly Father

Barbara Kaye Crandall was given life by her Creator on March 2, 1947, the daughter of Donald and Dorothy (Cooper) Helmel. She was given spiritual life and became a Child of God not long afterward through the gift of Holy Baptism. Galatians 3:26-27: "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. Barb was united in marriage to Bennie Allen Crandall on December 21, 1963. They were blessed with three children and a time of grace filled with Christian companionship and mutual support. They recently celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this past December 2023. **Psalm 128:3-4:** "Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the very heart of your house, your children like olive plants all around your table. Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the LORD."

Barbara enjoyed being a homemaker, and raising their three children at the home Bennie provided for; and still resides in. As her children grew, Barbara used her sewing skills to start her own slipcover business. She and her business partner visited many luxurious homes to recover and refresh outdated furniture. As years went by, she found caring for children as her calling; and spent many years as a personal nanny for several families. Once Bennie retired, they modified their home to accommodate the elderly as a licensed elder care facility. Barbara loved caring for others, always giving of herself.

Barb was committed to the truth of God's Word and understood by faith the payment her Savior made for her sins, living her life in thanks to Him. Over the years she maintained her confession of faith through membership at Berea Lutheran Church, Living Savior Lutheran Church, and Grace Lutheran Church.
