

He was committed to changing things: reconciling us to God by His life, death, and resurrection.

**David:** ... the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, ... (Titus 3:4) ... God did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, ... (Romans 8:32)

**Taylor:** In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. (1 John 4:10)

**Brooke:** For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His

Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. (Romans 5:10)

**Grades K-2:** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

# PART FOUR: THE EYES OF THE CHILDREN OF GOD

**Narrator:** Jesus' mission was to live out a perfect life in our place and then give His life as a payment for the penalty of sin. In doing so, God has declared the entire world of sinners as "not guilty," in His sight. This message of salvation is that which the Holy Spirit uses to draw the children of men to Him so that they become children of faith, God's very own children.

**Kenny:** I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake. (1 John 2:12)

**Rachel:** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. (John 1:12-13)



**Adam:** The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs -- heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, ... (Romans 8:16-17)

**Brandon:** For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (Galatians 3:26–27)

**Grade 4:** And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" (Galatians 4:6)

Children: WS 751: God's Own Child, I Gladly Say It

1. God's own child, I gladly say it: I am baptized into Christ!
He, because I could not pay it, Gave my full redemption price.
Do I need earth's treasures many? I have one worth more than any That brought me salvation free Lasting to eternity!

**Karie:** ... praise the name of the LORD, For His name alone is exalted; His glory *is* above the earth and heaven. And He has exalted the horn of His people, The praise of all His saints -- Of the children of Israel, A people near to Him. Praise the LORD! (Psalm 148:13-14)



**Abbie:** For as the heavens are high above the earth, *So* great is His mercy toward those who fear Him; As far as the east is from the west, *So* far has He removed our transgressions from us. As a father pities *his* children, *So* the LORD pities those who fear Him. (Psalm 103:11-13)

**Matthew:** Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. (Ephesians 5:1)

**Eric:** For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ... (Romans 8:14–16)

Congregation: TLH 647: O Little Town of Bethlehem

# PART FIVE: THE EYES OF CHILD-LIKE FAITH

**Narrator:** All of us very likely look at Christmas in times past, the days when we were younger and seemed to enjoy Christmas more. As we age our makeup and joy can become scarred by the impacts of this sinful world. But Christmas reminds us that Christ was born to resolve all this, coming into the world to take away our sin. As children of God, we need to simply believe this and place our total trust in our heavenly Father just as a little child places his trust in his parents. No matter what age we are, the joy and excitement of Christmas can be ours for we are all to be as little children toward our Savior, living in child-like faith.

**Ned:** Then they brought little children to [Jesus], that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought *them*.

Charles: But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them,

**Taylor:** "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God.

**David:** "Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it."

**Brooke:** And He took them up in His arms, put *His* hands on them, and blessed them. (Mark 10:13-16)



Children: WS 753: Let the Children Come to Me

- "Let the children come to Me, And forbid them not; To such belongs the kingdom. Come to set your children free. Let the children come to Me."

**Matthew:** You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. (1 John 4:4)

**Karie:** Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, *as* in your ignorance; ... (1 Peter 1:13-14)

**Christina:** Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain. (Philippians 2:14–16)




