#### Its All About Grace:

The word "grace" is a charming word. There is a hymn in our Lutheran Hymnal that begins: "Grace! 'tis a charming sound, harmonious to the ear ..." There is good reason why the name "Grace" was chosen for this congregation. The name is an acknowledgement of God's love, an expression of faith, as well as a witness to the message proclaimed from its pulpit.

Words take on different meanings to different people depending upon their understanding and the circumstances. Grace is a female name. It is used to define elegance or dignity, or even movement. It is used to describe a period of time following a due date- a grace period. Christians speak of saying grace, that is praying. But what is the meaning and significance of the word in the life of the church?

Grace is the "unmerited favor and love of God." God the Father is gracious because "God is love." In love He manifests His grace to sinful man, not because man is deserving, but because God Who desires the salvation of all is good! He is gracious.

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us ... when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son ..." (Romans 5:8,10). That is grace! The Apostle Paul rejoiced in the undeserved love of God as he testified that "the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant" (1 Timothy 1:14) toward him. Paul testified to this abundant grace in Ephesians 2:8: "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of ourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works lest anyone should boast." Paul had a future in heaven. By grace! Not by works or personal merit. By grace alone through faith alone! Scripture says, "And if by grace, then it is no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace; but if it is of works, it is no longer of grace; otherwise work is no more work" (Romans 11:6).

God has shown His grace to all in the person of Jesus Christ. He calls to all through the means of grace- the Gospel in Word and Sacrament in order that "faith which comes by hearing" may be created and sustained in the heart, for without faith in Christ it is not possible to enter into eternal life.

Under God's grace this congregation was begun. For fifty years Grace Lutheran Church has proclaimed the saving grace of God. This congregation will remain relevant so long as its message reflects the grace that gave it birth, the grace that brings salvation- so long as the Gospel of Christ remains the heart and core of its teaching. This congregation is all about grace- grace received and grace proclaimed. For 50 years of His grace, give thanks to God! By grace stand fast in grace.

- CLC News: Teacher Candice Ohlmann has returned the call to Our Savior's in Jamestown, ND. Graduate Jeffrey Karnitz has been called as an additional faculty member at St. Stephen in Mountain View, CA.
- ◆ CLC Convention: This past week the Lord richly blessed our Convention with fruitful devotions, discussion, and implementation of business matters. The theme of the Convention was, "The Fields are White for Harvest." Of interest is that the following former Grace confirmands were involved as delegates: Rick Nelson, Craig Ryan (elected to Board of Regents), Brian Radichel, Marty Rosendahl, Teacher Jay Sydow, Teacher Nathan Wales, and Pastor Joel Fleischer. Also attending the communion worship service were Neal Radichel, Jeff Radichel, Teresa (Nelson) Bernthal, and Joey Nelson. This in itself demonstrates how marvelously the Lord has blessed the training ground of our congregation with faithful servants even if some may no longer be members at Grace. In terms of business, due to a bequest into the Mission Development Fund, it was resolved to use the funding to start calling a second foreign missionary to work in India. The Convention also directed that the ILC Student Aid Fund Endowment be a top priority with a goal to fund it with a million dollars. This is an endowment in which the investment earnings of its principal are used to help students attending ILC with grants. loans, and scholarships. Currently the endowment has a principal of about \$255,000. In addition, the Convention decided to expand the proposed building project for ILC to not only include classrooms, but also office space and the library. The projected cost, including repurposing of Ingram Hall, is \$2.84 million. Designate donations toward this project as ILC Building. Many other issues of business were conducted and will be reported later.


