P: I cried out to You, O LORD; And to the LORD I made supplication:

C: "What profit is there in my blood, When I go down to the pit?

P: Will the dust praise You? Will it declare Your truth?

C: Hear, O LORD, and have mercy on me; LORD, be my helper!"

P: You have turned for me my mourning into dancing;

C: You have put off my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness,

P: To the end that my glory may sing praise to You and not be silent.

C: O LORD my God, I will give thanks to You forever.

SING: He lives to silence all my fears.

P: Jesus said: "This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved vou.

C: "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

P: "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.

C: "No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing;

P: but I have called you friends,

C: for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

He lives, my kind, wise, heavenly Friend,

He lives and loves me to the end; He lives, and while He lives, I'll sing; He lives, my Prophet, Priest, and King.

(Psalm 150:6)

P: Let everything that has breath praise the LORD.

C: Praise the LORD!

(John 14:2-3)

P: Jesus said: "In My Father's house are many mansions;

C: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

P: And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself;

C: that where I am, there you may be also."

SING: He lives and grants me daily breath;

He lives, and I shall conquer death: He lives my mansion to prepare;

He lives to bring me safely there.

(1 Corinthians 15:55-57)

P: "O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?"

C: The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law.

P: But thanks be to God.

C: who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

SING: He lives, all glory to His name!

He lives, my Jesus, still the same. Oh, the sweet joy this sentence gives,

"I know that my Redeemer lives!"
