- ♦ Hurricane Ike: Great news! Power was restored here at the parsonage and the church here at Bethel. Praise God! It had been out since about 2:30am early Sat. morning. We are truly blessed to have it back so quickly since they are still estimating that some areas around us (mainly north of us) still may not have power for 3-4 weeks. Thank you all so much for your concern and prayers for me, the congregation, and our area. They are very much appreciated. As far as I've heard everyone in our congregation is safe. Nearly all have had debris and tree damage, but few have had serious house damage. I know my dad sent out an email letting most of you know that our church roof suffered damage and there has been leakage and some pretty substantial water damage esp. to the balcony of church. It smells and looks like there is already a mold problem in there. That is a major concern for us which may take a while to fix because of the location of the damage on a high, steep roof. The parsonage roof took some damage on one of its peaks as well, but the leakage wasn't great enough to seep through the attic. We do have a restoration and roofing company coming out to assess the damage and begin restoration/repair work. ... We all appreciate your continued prayers. Please also continue to pray for the people in Galveston and the coastal / flooded areas who have sustained much more damage and face much greater hardship than we have here north of Houston. - Pastor Luke Bernthal
- ◆ Mission Word in South Africa: Many are the Plans in the Mind of Man. but it is the Lord's Purpose that Will Be Established. Prov. 19:21 - One of our men from the ELCC (Congo) has now located in Johannesburg, South Africa and is trying to gather French speakers into a worship and congregation. Our man, Denis Mulumba, had been having up to 20 in a service, when the devil decided that was enough of that. Riots broke out by native South Africans against foreigners who they thought were taking their jobs. The people who had been coming were scattered as people fled for their lives from this area. Denis' family was protected by Zulu friends who got them away. The family's possessions were lost. Now Denis has relocated in a different area and will try to find the people who were scattered. Pray for his outreach efforts. He, like the apostle Paul, is doing 'tentmaking' work trying to work on computers and develop some contracts in this. Denis prays that in a year a group may be gathered such that they may register with the government. We put our trust in the Lord to bring forth the fruits of this work despite the devil's raging. In a visit to Johannesburg I was able to talk with Denis about the work. I also met his wife, Esther Nsamba, and baptized their baby, Eden Mbuyi. - Missionary David Koenig
