Once the Christ candle is lit, the congregation is invited to come forward and light a candle from the Christ candle. Your candle will be presented to you by the usher. You may light your candle by tipping it to another lighted candle, but please do not tip a lighted candle. We ask that only children ages 5 and older hold their own candles.
