OPENING DIALOG:

P: Unto us a Child is born, Hallelujah!
C: **Unto us a Son is given, Hallelujah!**
P: The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us.
C: **And we beheld His glory, the glory as of the Only-begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.**
P: Oh, come, let us worship Him:
C: **Let us kneel before the Lord in the manger. Hallelujah!**

Pastor: And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) And all went to be taxed, everyone into his own city.

A glad new year to all the earth.


CONFESSON OF FAITH:..... The Christmas Creed
