People across the nation and around the world are being told by Harold Camping, of the Family Radio Network, that Judgment Day will come on Saturday, May 21. According to Camping, there will be catastrophic earthquakes on that day, and believers will be raptured ("caught up") to heaven. Those left behind will live in misery until October 21, when the universe will supposedly be destroyed. Camping has made more than one false prediction of the end of the world before, though he left himself some "wiggle room" with those previous dates. Now he has flatly declared, in a nation-wide media campaign, that May 21 is the only possible date. Here in Eau Claire, a billboard and several advertising trucks are falsely proclaiming that Judgment Day will be this Saturday.

Jesus said "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only." Mt. 24:36. In spite of this, Mr. Camping believes his calculations, based on subjective combinations of numbers in the Bible, reveal a hidden "truth." When none of these things happen on May 21, he will be revealed for the false prophet that he is. Sadly, many non-Christians will no doubt use this spectacle as an excuse to ignore the second coming of our Lord Jesus entirely.

On our part, the Lord urges us to:

- Watch out for false teachers (Mt. 7:15);
- Be ready, by personal repentance and faith in Christ, for His return at *any* time (Mt. 24:42);
- Urge others to find that same Savior in the person of Jesus (Mark 16:15-16).
