- CLC giving is \$4,000 behind budget plan year-to-date.

Pastor's Report

- Brandon Gehrls has requested to be removed from membership. A motion was passed to recommend to Voters that he be removed.
- The confirmations of Charles Davis, Emily Hein, John Maki, and Ned Sandhoefner on May 22 were noted.
- Julie Brandt and Christopher Fleming wedding on July 9
- Contacts:
 - Matt Snyder desires membership and has been attending services in Eden Prairie. Pastors Hein and Schierenbeck both believe that Matt's understanding of faith and doctrine is such that he is ready.
 - Pastor Alexander, friend of Alvin Jask in Liberia, has been corresponding with Pastor Hein and is receiving instruction

- Alvin Jask's sister and her daughter desire to come here from Liberia and receive instruction. They have financing in order and are now attempting to obtain Visas.
- Becky Koch, a U of M student, needs transportation to church. Discussion followed on how to assist her.
