Meeting opened with prayer. Roll call was taken: 23 present; 4 excused; and 9 absent. Minutes of the April 17 meeting were approved as read.

Treasure's Report:

- Until June, receipts have been good. June receipts were down.
- Giving to the Tuition Aid Fund was up significantly.
- All the boards are in line with their budgets.
- The bill for the windows and skylights was paid in June.
- Giving to the CLC continues to be down, about \$5,000 from last year.

Pastor's Report

- Brandon Gehrls, who has been attending a heterodox church, has requested that his membership at Grace be removed. Motion carried.
- Ken and Darlene Isaacson are attending an ELCA church and have requested the removal of their membership. Motion carried.
- Steven Gunther has been unreachable for several years. Motion to remove his membership due to loss of contact was approved.
- John Auel is attending a heterodox church and hasn't responded to several contact attempts. Motion to remove membership approved.
- Andrew Rosendahl hasn't responded to correspondence to date. No recommendation for any action was made.
- 12 families and/or individuals were sent letters via certified mail regarding their attendance and participation in the means of Grace:
 - Three letters were not signed for.
 - One recipient is meeting with Pastor.
 - o One recipient came to church today.
 - Pastor read the letter to the voters.
 - Letter recipients were: Josh and Laurie Benzer; Jonathan Davis; Judy Dahlin; Jeriamiah Smith; Jessica Stiebling; Matt Stiebling; Justin and Sarah Walker.
- The confirmations of Charles Davis, Emily Hein, John Maki, and Ned Sandhoefner on May 22 were noted. Affirmation of their communicant membership was approved by the voters.
- Matt Snyder, who has been faithfully attending services at Eden Prairie, wants to become a member of the CLC. Pastors Hein and Schierenbeck recommend his membership. Pastor Hein read Matt's letter declaring his faith to the voters. A motion to approve his membership passed. (Since the Eden Prairie is not yet a congregation, membership must occur at Grace or Berea).
- Continuing instruction classes with Rona Flesner and Alex Baker who have another six sessions to go. Pastor Alexander Gayflor in Libya, a contact of Alvin Jask, is being instructed via email.
- Alvin Jask's sister Suzie and her daughter Naomi are attempting to come to the U.S. for instruction. Suzie also plans to seek help and advice from Janelle Hein with regard to running a Christian day

- school something Suzie wants to do on her return to Libya. They have financing in place but are encountering complications with their visa applications. Please keep them in your prayers.
- Julie Brandt and Christopher Fleming were married on July 9.
- Freida Aden will likely be moving back to the area from Florida.

Board of Elders

 The Elders recommend moving the date for our Mission Festival from Oct. 9 to Sept. 25 when Missionary Matthew Ude will be here and available to preach. A motion to move the date was approved.

Board of Education

- The Board recommends the appointment of Rick Nelson as Sunday School Superintendant for the coming year. Motion passed.
- The Board recommends calling Heidi Nelson and Jan Davis to serve as substitute teachers for the coming school year. Motion carried.
- Pastor reminded us that we still need one more VBS teacher.

Board of Trustees

- The new windows and skylights have all now been installed.
- The board is seeking bids for sealing the parking lot.
 - One bid has been received to date: seal with new rock and stripe - \$8,346.00, or seal coat only w/o rock - \$4,446.00
- Roof leaks: The board is still seeking solutions to this problem.
- The board sought guidance on prioritizing the projects since there isn't enough money to address all the issues. Discussion followed. It was noted that there was \$1352.00 in the Project Undesignated fund, and \$5,000.00 in the Project Reserve fund.
- A motion was made and passed to move both funds to the General Fund to be available for the Trustees to use for the above mentioned projects at their discretion.

Old Business

- A blood drive has been scheduled after church, Sept. 25. Donors may sign up over the next two weeks.
- Changes to the constitution and by-laws, second reading. Proposal One, parts one and two, and Proposal Two passed.
 - Proposal 1 effected the elimination of the office of Financial Secretary and the transfer of the duties of that office to the Vice Chairman.
 - Proposal 2 effected the addition of two members from the board of Education to the Nominating Committee, in the process redefining which members of each board may be selected to serve on the committee.

New Business

There was no new business.
