- Andrew Rosendahl. Pastor and the Board of Elders are continuing encouragement with Andrew's attendance. A motion to remove Andrew from voting membership per his request was passed.
- Jonathan Davis. There has been no response from Jonathan. The Board made a motion to remove from membership. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- Changes to the By-Laws
 - Change #1. Modification of the wording in Section 2 Election Procedures, with regard to new make-up of the nominating committee. A motion was made to drop the words a designated and add the words the second year in the following sentence: "Each year a nominating committee, consisting of a designated the second year member of the Board of Elders, Board of Trustees, and Board of Christian Education and the pastor, shall propose a slate...." The motion passed.
 - Change #2. Modification of the wording in Section 7 Auxiliary Officers and Committees. A motion was made to add the following sentence to paragraph 5: If any delegate or alternate delegate is unable to attend, then any Grace voter may be appointed by the delegation present as a substitute with the ability to vote at the delegate conference and the CLC convention. The motion passed.
- A change to the handbook with regard to the provision for assistance for the pastor with communion distribution – page 2, WORSHIP section, paragraph G. A motion was made to add the following sentence: In the event that assistance for communion distribution is still needed, the pastor in conjunction with the elders will make a selection of a member to assist. The motion was passed.

 Modification of the 2011 church calendar. A motion was made to change the calendar regarding mid-week Advent services, because of where Christmas falls. Drop November 30th and add December 21st, which will now be the Candlelight Service. The motion passed.

New Business

- A report on the September 18 Delegate Conference at Eagle Lake was delivered by Dave Rust. Dave reported that all 3 essays presented were excellent, one of which was timely, and addressed the loss of many of our youth's continued membership in the CLC.
