# **Council Meeting Notes – April 1, 2012**

The meeting opened with prayer. Minutes of the March 11 meeting were approved as read with minor corrections and the inclusion of the trustees' report.

#### Treasurer's Report:

 March expenses exceeded income by \$5,783.61 due to a disbursement from the Tuition Aid Fund.

#### Pastor's Report:

- Brian Naumann has orally requested a transfer of his membership to Messiah in Eau Claire. A motion to approve was passed.
- The 2012 Grace Yearbook has been completed and distributed by e-mail of a PDF file, and some hard copies were printed and left by the mailboxes.
- Pastor noted the approaching Good Friday and Easter services.

#### **Board of Elders: No report.**

#### **Board of Education Report:.**

- A motion to offer Kindergarten classes next year as mentioned in the March council meeting was passed and will be referred to the voters for final approval.
- A motion to call Ann Radichel to teach Kindergarten for one year without salary passed and will be referred to the voters for final approval.
- The history fair was a success.
- The Iowa Basic tests will be conducted April 23.
- Field Day will be on May 11 at Berea.
- The Grace School spring program will be on the evening of May 24 at 7:00.
- The boys' rest room sink has a leak. The sinks in both rest rooms will be replaced.
- The flyer for the school is ready to be printed and distributed.
- A notice for enrollment for school next year will be printed in the bulletin.

#### **Board of Trustees Report:**

- The annual audit was completed on March 26. The books are in good order.
   The Treasurer is to commended for his efforts. A copy of the report was given to the secretary to be kept on file.
- Pastor Hein noted some property concerns: the retaining wall by the garage needs attention, the overflow parking lot is getting very rough, the southwest corner of lot has cracked due to water seepage, the area around the shed has little grass and could be improved with patio blocks, church sign needs cleaning.

#### **Old Business:**

- Electronic distribution of council meeting minutes discussion continued from the last meeting. Keeping the minutes discreet prior to publication after final approval was a concern. The minutes still need to be read at the meeting rather than just asking for corrections or additions. Benno recommended some sort of hard copy distribution one week prior to the next meeting.
- Virtual meetings discussion continued from the last meeting including the need for guidelines, and some guideline specifics were discussed. The CLC Trustees will look into developing some suggested guidelines for the individual churches.
- Harassment policy development of one continues, and the CLC Trustees hope to have something prepared to present to the CLC Convention.
- Church mail boxes have been reorganized. 16 empty slots remain in random locations for future expansion. Larger slots were created for the Pastor, secretary, and treasurer. A bulletin board was added.
- Follow-up question for the Board of Education: Is the board prepared for the possible increase of students that distribution of the school flyer may produce, and how many students can the school accommodate? Response: That is a good question which the board will consider.
