#### Brief Biography: ...... With TLH 648: I Am Jesus' Little Lamb

The pilgrimage of Curt Richard Miesen through this world of sin and sorrow into the victorious glory of heaven may be summed up as follows: His earthly pilgrimage began when he was born on March 30, 1960, in Salt Lake City, UT, the son of Richard and Jenettie Miesen. On April 12, 1960, Curt became a child of God by the power of the Holy Spirit through Holy Baptism. He made his public confession of faith with his confirmation vows on June 30, 1974, at Redeemer Lutheran Church in Bowdle, SD, his memory passage being the words of our Savior Jesus Christ found in John 14:6: "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

SING(J): I am Jesus' little lamb, Ever glad at heart I am; For my Shepherd gently guides me, Knows my need, and well provides me, Loves me every day the same, Even calls me by my name.

Curt married Nancy Dummer and blessed their union with two children, Andrea and Matthew. Curt worked for the United State Postal Service as a postal carrier, beginning in 1984 and mostly serving the area of Brooklyn Park. Curt enjoyed sports and was an active bowler and golfer. He also enjoyed trivia and hanging out with his children. Curt was a member at Grace Lutheran Church in Fridley since 1979, believing in the payment His Savior made for his sins: "For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's" (1 Corinthians 6:20).

Curt was summoned to be with his Savior on January 13, 2013, after experiencing and being treated for leukemia, his time of grace here on earth being 52 years. His earthly remains await the resurrection on the Last Day of the world when our Lord will invite all of His believers: "Come, you blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" (Matthew 25:34).

Curt was preceded in death by his father, Richard. He is survived by his daughter, Andrea; son, Matthew; mother, Jenettie; and brother, Dale (Dianne); niece, nephews, and many other friends. We are thankful for the Lord blessing us with Curt in our lives. "The LORD gave, the LORD has taken away. Blessed be the name of the LORD" (Job 1:21).
