¹⁵ For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. ¹⁶ If, then, I do what I will not to do, I agree with the law that *it is* good. ¹⁷ But now, *it is* no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. ¹⁸ For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but *how* to perform what is good I do not find. ¹⁹ For the good that I will *to do*, I do not do; but the evil I will not *to do*, that I practice. ²⁰ Now if I do what I will not *to do*, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. ²¹ I find then a law, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good. ²² For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. ²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. ²⁴ O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ²⁵ I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin. (NKJVTM)

Comments:

- General Fund offerings were \$893,950
- Bank CD interest of \$6,189 added to the offerings makes the total \$900,140 that was spent in the General Fund
- ILC Student receipts were lower than plan by \$31,411
- General Fund Reserves usage was \$3,201 less than planned
- Overall operating account spending was \$34,472 less than planned
- The budget plan for the next year is less than what was spent last year largely due to the Convention approving the payoff of the medical plan debt in the Trustee budget
- Continued downward pressure in the ILC student revenue due to lower enrollments is a cause for concern and prayer
- All auxiliary funds ended the year with a balance
- Detailed financial reports from all funds and accounts will be published in the 2014 Convention Proceedings
