Nothing is unknown, for better or for worse depending on where one is in relationship to the Lord! Upon death one is eternally lost in hell, or enjoys the bliss of heaven. While Satan and our flesh daily seek to drive Christ-believers to alarm of what is termed the unknown, we may live in peace and confidence. There is nothing unknown—or to fear-concerning the state of the Christ-believer after death.

To know what remains unknown to many by reason of unbelief we turn to God's Word:

"If you abide in My Word ... you shall know the truth..." (John 8:32).

"Sanctify them by Your truth, Your word is truth" (John 17:17).

"Then He who sat on the throne ... said to me, 'Write, for these words are true and faithful'" (Revelation 21:5)
