Dear Members of Grace Lutheran,

Last Sunday the Voters met to consider calling a second full-time teacher for our school due to an expanding student enrollment. This call would begin for the next school year.

With 21 current students, having the students in one classroom with one full-time teacher creates a limit on the number of students our school can have. Next school year we are already anticipating 26 students, even if no interest is received from outside our congregation. This means some sort of solution is needed beyond what we have now. By adding a second full-time teacher there will be the ability to have two classrooms with additional capacity, the grades divided between upper grades and lower grades. Furthermore, it permits the reopening of the Kindergarten.

At its October meeting, the Voters resolved to have this second full-time teacher and adopted a budget (including increased non-member tuition) that would permit this. Last Sunday they called from within the congregation to fill this need. The call to teach the lower grades was extended to Heidi Nelson.

Please pray that the Lord would lead Heidi in her deliberations. Considering a call is always a challenging time for the individual and the family, and undoubtedly for Heidi at this time as well as for Rick. Heidi will be weighing her God-given gifts with the needs of the Lord's call, as well as considering how this all would work with her family's current situation. May the Lord in His grace give her confidence through His promises that He will lead her to do His will. Please also pray for the school in general, that the Lord who has given us the opportunity to minister to these young lambs in His kingdom would also give us the ability to support this.

May the Lord continue to richly bless us with His Word!
