

General Fund – April offerings of **\$76,721** (incl \$6,253 special) vs disbursements of \$72,100, resulted in a \$4,621 positive cash flow, increasing our current balance to \$17,101. The General Fund Budget calls for \$88,575 monthly to fund the work of our Boards of Missions, Regents, Trustees, & Ed-Pub.

ILC Operations – Revenue of \$100,613 (incl \$47,875 subsidy) vs disbursements of \$101,710.

ILC Building Projects – Offerings of \$2,930 vs the \$8,000 monthly loan payment for the AC loan.

CEF – Revenue of \$38,506 (Cong CEF loan repayments) vs disbursements of \$12,091 for promissory note debt service & admin expenses.

MDF-Offerings of \$4,698 vs disbursements of \$4,191, (Mission Helper, Exploratory, Admin Expense).

SAF – Revenue of \$10,059 (\$7,121 STU loan payments, \$2,937 offerings) vs \$9,924 grants & loans.

Kinship – Offerings \$26,227 (\$19,650 Orphan & Student Sponsor gifts; \$6,577 Cong & Special gifts, vs disbursements of \$11,666 (\$10,000 Foreign Missions COVID-19 aid; \$1,166 Admin & students.

Despite our membership having to continue to shelter at home due to pandemic concerns and to endure related difficulties, the General Fund offering shortfall in March did <u>not</u> trend into April and result in a further shortfall. The Lord has continued to bless & strengthen faith by providing alternate ways of bringing His Means of Grace to us, even as He has continued to bless our material means & provide alternate ways to bring them in gratitude for His gracious blessings.

Especially in difficult times like this our Lord counsels & comforts us: "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" (Psalm 46:10)

<u>Council Meeting Notes – April 26, 2020</u>

Note: March 2020 Council meeting was cancelled by Chairman Rick Nelson.

Meeting (conducted online via Zoom app) opened with prayer and a short devotion at 11:00 am. February minutes read and approved. Treasurer reports for the months of February and March were read and approved.

Pastor's Report

- Alyssa Johannes membership transferred from Messiah in Eau Claire, WI.
- Pastor continues to conduct instruction classes with 3 individuals: Joseph Thomas, Tom Graham, and Grant Wells (grandson to Frank & Ann Radichel).
- Catechism classes are continuing online.
- An online midweek Bible class on Wednesday evening has been started.
- ILC Tour Choir may be rescheduled in June or July (very tentative).
- The Minnesota Delegate Conference and the CLC Convention have been rescheduled to June 8-10, 2020 and July 30-August 2, 2020, respectively.

Board of Elders Report

- Services at Grace remain suspended per the Covid 19 executive order by the Governor of MN. Plans are to continue with the present weekly service pack emailed by Pastor. The Elders continue to monitor the situation.
- Ryan Mueller is keeping his eyes open for a used pipe organ to replace our current organ and has one to consider. Frank shared pictures of the organ.
 Some discussion regarding this, but no need yet for a decision.

Board of Education Report

- Teachers providing weekly lessons and getting feedback from the families.
- The doors for two classrooms have been updated to include windows and locks. An updated school office door has also been installed.
- Spring Lake Park has cancelled its parade for this summer.

Board of Trustees Report

- Carpet has been installed in upstairs bedrooms of parsonage.
- Spring cleanup day has been postponed.
- Work on the church grounds continues, including clean up in the lilacs.
- Service was done on the parsonage furnaces. Gas pressure was checked, a
 gas regulator was checked and cleaned up, and a new fan was installed.
- Pastor mentioned that a lot of members have been helping with various tasks. He is thankful for all the work being done.
- The mower has been worked on and should be ready to go for the summer.
- Work needs to be done on the lawn north of the parsonage. This is in the area that was dug up when work was done on the water line.

Other Business

 Discussion regarding online contributions from members. A service could be used, but with a cost involved. Receiving contributions via US Mail seems to be working fine for now although Pastor requests to have less direct involvement with it. Option of setting up a PO Box was considered.
