- **Thanks** to retired pastor, Daniel Fleischer, for sharing the Word today. He and his wife, Barb, are members at Grace.

- ➡ Masks: Due to the Governor's executive order, face coverings or masks are now required during worship at Grace. Children under the age of 2 are exempt. Ages 2-5 "are encouraged to wear a face covering when in public if they can do so reliably ..." Also, pastor does not need to wear one while leading the worship service.
- ➡ Physical Distancing: The pews are set up to be alternating, post-its on the pews that are to be used. Our ushers are asked to be proactive when ushering people in so that distancing between household units can be better accomplished. Also, please remember to do your visiting outside away from the building before and after worship, ensuring that the doorway isn't blocked by a group. Thank you for being mindful of your fellow Christians.
- **Sunday School:** Those interested in teaching or subbing may speak with either Pastor or Ryan Oman.
- Service Schedule: The Sunday schedule will be changing next Sunday, Sept. 13. Sunday School will begin at 9:00 am with regular morning worship at 10:00 am. The intent is to begin Bible Class on Oct. 4. Our members are strongly encouraged to take advantage of these classes to strengthen themselves spiritually through the "one thing needful" during their life's journey. Lord's Supper Plan for Today at Grace

There will be some adjustments to how the Lord's Supper is served, which are as follows:

- → Pastor will be the only one serving the Lord's Supper and will be using sanitizer after each table.
- → The ushers will invite smaller groups of communicants to come forward.
- → The communicants are to physically distance by household groups, both in line and at the altar.
- → After waiting in line, the communicants should remove their masks as they begin to walk up to the altar.
- → The ushers will offer sanitizer as each group comes forward.
- → The communicants are to line up at the floor level. If there are three household groups, often one can stand at the far left, one at the center, and one at the far right. If there are two groups, then one at the far left and one at the far right.
- → Pastor will drop the wafers into people's hands on the first pass. Please be sure to extend both hands together so that he is able to do this easily.
- → Only individual cups will be served, which will be placed on a table behind where the communicants stand. Please take a cup from the table when invited to do so by the Pastor, touching only the cup. He will then invite the whole group to drink together.
- → The cups are to be disposed in the container located in the front pews, as normal.
- → The communicants should put their masks back on as they return to their pews.
- → Some have expressed a desire to have the Lord's Supper after the worship service for various reasons. Pastor will be accommodating this for those who wish to do so. He asks that those who wish to do this will contact him ahead of time.
- → If anyone desires private communion, please contact Pastor and he will certainly do this upon request.
