

Pastor: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Congregation: Amen.

P: Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God;

C: And everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

P: He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

C: In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

P: In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

C: Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

Sing [♪]: I was in bondage, Sin, death, and darkness;

Therefore I'll say again:

God loves me dearly, God loves me dearly, loves even me.

P: Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

C: And we have known and believed the love that God has for us.

P: God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

C: Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

P: There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.


C: We love Him because He first loved us.
