Meeting opened with prayer. Motion approved to accept Grant Wells as a voting member. January 2021 Voters meeting minutes read and approved. Treasurer's 1st quarter report presented and approved: 1) \$3400 in tuition aid dispersed; 2) workers' gift distributed; 3) \$2021 total in Tour Choir offerings; 4) budget is on target for income, under budget on expenses.

- Ben and Barb Crandall were transferred from Living Savior (Eden Prairie, MN).
- Pastor officiated at the wedding of Brandon Wendland in Las Vegas on March 12.
- ILHS Visitors Day is April 30 with 2 students attending. Confirmation is May 23. An examination of the 3 confirmands will be held at 9 am that same day.

Board of Elders Report

- To provide more seating in the sanctuary, an additional pew at the back of each the 2 large sections and chairs by the parents' room can now be used.
- Communion: using the tables for wine will be replaced by using the communion ware trays to distribute the individual cups; no common cup as of yet.
- The Elders reviewed attendance at voters' meetings and encouraged better attendance. Motion approved to remove the voting membership of Alex Baker per his request. Motion approved to remove the voting membership of Joel Stifter per his request.

Board of Education Report

- The school is on track to meet the mandated number of days for school.
- The following events will not be held this year: field day, basketball tournament, and the Spring Lake Park parade.

Board of Trustees Report

- The yearly audit was completed on April 5. Everything was in order. Thank you to Brian for his good work.
- Video doorbells have been installed but need a little work to improve their signal.
 A second server is being ordered for the security system.
- Fire insurance claim is wrapping up. The insurance premium will be going up.
- A church workday is scheduled for this coming Saturday (April 24).


Other Business

- The church organ is nearing the end of its life and replacing it should be considered. An organ fund exists and currently has a value of roughly \$10,000.
 Motion approved to form an organ committee consisting of Dale Enns, Frank Radichel, Maureen Ochsner, Jan Davis, Janelle Hein, & Sue Nelson, to evaluate options and make a recommendation.
- Sanctuary Improvement: Rick mentioned wanting to form a committee consisting of himself, Barb Sydow, John Maki, and Krista Sandhoefner. The role of the committee would be to make interior design recommendations. Funding would be provided by the Memorials (Projects Undesignated) fund. Benno mentioned that there have been several improvement items considered over the years. Some of the items were even discussed in prior voters' meetings. He suggests that we have a congregational meeting to ensure members are given ample opportunity to give their input on the improvements. Motion approved to convene congregational meetings to discuss sanctuary/narthex upgrades.
