<u>Voter Meeting Notes – July 18, 2021</u>

Meeting opened with prayer. April Voters meeting minutes read & approved. Treasurer's report presented & approved.

Pastor's Report

- Ed and Verona Lentz transferred to Living Savior in Eden Prairie.
- Kevin and Sandy Hulke transferred to Grace from Messiah in Eau Claire.
- Motion passed to ratify the communicant membership of the confirmands: Alexandra Baker, Sienna Boe, and Naomi Story.
- MN Delegate Conference held on June 5. CLC Convention held June 24-27. At Convention, the Joint Statement was not accepted. A new gym for ILC was proposed while other needs around the CLC were discussed as well.
- VBS will be this coming week. Roughly 23 children are scheduled to attend.
 The staff is all set.
- Pastor Terrel Kesterson (Batavia, IL) accepted an invite to preach for Mission Festival tentatively for Oct 10. Travel expenses for airfare will be covered.

Board of Elders Report

- Plans are to return to pre-COVID protocols once the Fall service schedule begins. Ushers will return to passing the offering plates through the pews.
- Organ Update: Committee has met a few times. Other CLC congregations have been contacted as part of the committee's research. Secured the use of a digital demo organ from Phoenix through CLC member, Barry Hay, for all of July and into August. Considered pipe organs as an option but they are more expensive. The purchase of an organ should be considered an investment that will last 25-30 years. The 2019 demo organ is ~\$45k, similar new organ is ~\$53k. Demo would include a 10-year warranty. No recommendation yet from the committee since evaluations haven't been completed. Messiah in Eau Claire and Gethsemane in Spokane Valley have higher level Phoenix organs which run ~\$85k. Speakers would be placed behind alter in the upper level w/holes cut in the wall for speakers. The committee is considering a visit to Messiah in Eau Claire to learn about their organ. Organ pipes could be used as a decorative cover for the speaker openings. Replacement parts are perhaps easier to acquire since they aren't exclusive to Phoenix and are readily available. A suggestion made to set a fundraising goal to keep the members informed and only make the organ purchase when most of the funds have been acquired.

Board of Education Report

- The school year finished up will little impact from COVID.
- A field day for Grace's students was held at the school.
- Iowa Basic tests were held.
- A total of 3 new non-member students have been enrolled for the upcoming school year. Total enrollment is projected to be 25.

Board of Trustees Report

- The new door opener has a switch on the bottom of the unit. Recommend using the "Automatic" setting which enables the switches. "Hold Open" can be used in warmer weather if ushers choose to keep the doors open.
- Upcoming projects include refinishing the parsonage deck and getting gutters installed on the south side of the parsonage.
- Estimates (~\$4k) have been received for replacing caulk in the outdoor seams of the outer walls of the church and fellowship hall.
- The 2 school entry door frames are rusting and will need to be replaced. Work is being done to line up a contractor.
- Playground equipment is being worked on to improve its overall safety.
- Funds remain for fire restoration work. Quotes are being sought for the driveway repair which still needs to be completed. Will be able to replace the remaining lost items with funds still available.

 Motion to form a committee to work on the sanctuary improvement project consisting of John Maki, Rick Nelson, Krista Sandhoefner, and Barb Sydow.
