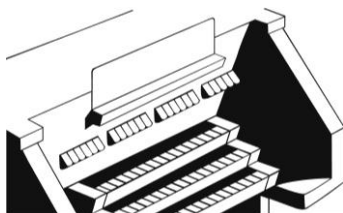

Organ Project Update:

The LORD has certainly moved hearts to contribute to the new Phoenix organ! This is a testament to how much Grace appreciates and values the opportunity to worship the LORD. The Council recently discussed how we are close to the Voters' target of \$55,000, short by about \$4,000. There could be some additional costs that could be covered by the fund for sanctuary preparations. Due to supply chain issues, the earliest the organ could arrive is in May. But Barry Hay, the Phoenix Organs representative, believes delivery may most likely land in June even though this may even be uncertain.



With the upcoming arrival of the new organ, a few different projects need to be completed. This past week numerous volunteers helped with phase 1 of the preparations by cutting two holes in the wall, one on each side of the altar of the church. These were covered with fabric which was framed in. Shelves for the forthcoming organ speakers were constructed in the small room behind these holes. Storage shelves were also reconstructed in between.

Phase 2 of the project will be threading wires through ductwork from the back of the church where the organ platform is to where the speakers will sit. Phase 3 will be reconstruction of the organ platform to allow for more space. This remaining work is anticipated to take place over the next couple of weeks.

We thank all those who helped assist with the work thus far, including the extensive cleaning work that took place in the sanctuary this past Friday.
