Council Meeting Notes - July 10, 2022

Meeting opened with prayer. June Council meeting minutes read and approved. Treasurer's report presented and approved. No Pastor's or Elders' report was presented.

Board of Education Report

- Work is being done on the growth plan, swapping the north and south rooms, and removing the computers from Mrs. Hein's room. The north room, which now includes the library, has been put back together.
- Volunteer classroom help is being sought and the board is considering someone who has expressed interest.
- Other Items: 1) With a larger enrollment, new lockers will be needed; 2) Al will be installing new outlets for the PC's, 3) 6 new desks have been purchased, 4) Might need to arrange for a new substitute teacher, 5) Trying to wrap up things before VBS, 6) Air filters have been purchased, 7) A cleaning day has been scheduled for Aug. 6, 8) First day of school is Aug. 29.

Board of Trustees Report

- Copier issues have been resolved. A new infuser was installed and scanning functionality was restored.
- Work is being done to resolve some issues with the fire alarm.
- Carpet cleaning in the school is scheduled for this coming Wednesday.
- Plan is to purchase fencing materials and repair the fence ourselves.
- A cable will need to be run before the new security camera can be installed.
- A lot of the folding chairs should be replaced. Maybe we could get new ones or rent them when needed. Some discussion followed.
- New carpet for the organ area should be installed soon so that the area is ready before the new organ arrives. Some discussion followed with the recommendation that the Trustees should proceed.

Other Business

- The new organ likely won't be here until the end of July. Some discussion on how to proceed with the organ area in regard to moving cabinets and the recording equipment.
- Some discussion on the treasurer report format. This was in response to a question of what was talked about on the subject in June council meeting.
- The drain in north classroom sometimes backs up. Will need to be cleaned.
- Some discussion on salary increases and a new guideline Dale proposed to aid the Board of Elders and the Board of Education.
