Prayer before the Lord's Supper:

Strengthen my faith, increase my love and hope in You, and assure me of Your blessed peace. Hear me for the sake of Jesus, my dear Savior, Amen.

Meeting opened with prayer. Motion approved to accept Daniel Hein as a voting member. April voters meeting minutes read and approved. Treasurer's report reviewed and approved.

Treasurer's Report

• Organ fund looking good. There are sufficient funds to cover the purchase of the organ and the new carpeting that is needed for the organ platform.

Pastor's Report

- Beth Sorenson was transferred to St. John's in Okabena, MN, in June.
- Rick Grams and Jenettie Miesen recently passed away. Both funerals went well. Thanks to the Dorcas Guild service groups who helped with luncheons.
- Motion approved to remove Andrea Dahl and her children (Benno & Sydney)
 per her request. She wants to be a member of a church that both she and
 her husband can mutually agree upon.
- Motion approved to remove Tawnya Simon per her request. She disagrees with the Bible's teaching regarding the Sixth Commandment.
- Motion approved to remove Joey Simon (now an adult) given the lack of interest and follow through with confirmation instruction.
- MN Delegate conference was held Sat., June 11. Attendees included Pastor, delegates Benno Sydow & Tom Graham, and Dave Rust. CLC Convention was held June 23-26. Attendees included Pastor and delegates Benno & Tom.
- Members from Grace walked in the Spring Lake Park Parade in June. This is such a good outreach effort for the church and school.
- VBS enrollment currently is at 24.
- Liberia: Joseph Kwiwalazu has been having classes at Global Village and with an independent Methodist group which wants to translate some materials.

Board of Elder's Report

- Livestreaming of services is available.
- Work is being done to connect with members who haven't been in attendance lately. Not much of a response yet.

Board of Education Report

- Spring Lake Park Parade: 31 members from Grace participated, 450 fliers distributed, 700 pencils distributed. There was some interest in the school and VBS after people received the fliers. Thanks to Rick Nelson for help with the shirts, fliers, and pencils and to David Hein for the use of his pickup.
- Projected Enrollment for 2022-23: 10 in grades K-2; 21 in grades 3-8; 13
 Grace members; 18 non-members. One family is very interested in sending their children to Grace but wants to wait until both their children can attend.
- Classroom Updates: north room cleaned out and the library and PC's moved there, power supplies still needed for PC's and will be installed by Al, dry

erase boards were removed from the south room walls with wall repair and painting next, need carpet cleaning in the south classroom, need to remount screen and projector in the south classroom, more lockers are needed, perhaps Duane Enns could help with construction.

- The school is blessed with growth potential. To accommodate this:
 - Short-term Plan: Purchased new desks, keep the split in grades, will need some volunteers to help out
 - Long-term Plan (so far): Have all 3 classrooms staffed for all hours of the day, expect an increase in the non-member tuition rate
- The board is considering the tuition rate for a couple of different student situations: 1) student isn't a Grace member but is a CLC member, 2) student isn't a Grace member but their parent(s) are currently attending instruction.
- Upcoming Dates of Note: VBS: July 25-29; School workday: August 6; Ice cream social: August 23; First day of school: August 29
- Thanks to volunteers who have put in many hours on school improvements.

Board of Trustees Report

- Business as usual with several projects in the works.
- Currently supporting the Board of Ed in their work with the school.
- Carpet is ordered for organ platform and will be installed once it arrives.

Other Business

• Benno Sydow and Tom Graham spoke about the CLC Convention: electronic voting via electronic device was used and results were posted immediately; ~\$12-19 million needed for the building project which includes a new gym, media center, fine arts center, and chapel ... funding for the new building project to be secured before breaking ground; vote passed to contact WELS and ELS with specific concerns the CLC has with their position on termination of fellowship; Christian education as an outreach effort was discussed with a proposal to start a new board to oversee this work which was not approved as the work will fall under the existing boards; CLC budget has seen increases and this year's deficit will be covered by reserves from previous years; there is a need for increased contributions from the congregations; communion service was held at Messiah.

New Organ and Sanctuary Improvement

- Question on the progress of the acoustics consultation and interior design plans. There is nothing to report now since Rick Nelson isn't here today.
- Volunteer help needed to move items when new carpet is installed by organ.
- The organ fund balance is sufficient for the organ purchase and the additional installation expenses. Motion approved to close the organ fund with any unused funds going to the Project Undesignated Fund.
- Latest is that organ will be shipped to Barry Hay early/mid-August.
