Council Meeting Notes – January 8, 2023

Meeting opened with prayer. December Council meeting minutes read and approved. Treasurer's report was presented and approved. \$1800 was disbursed to 4 organists (\$450 ea.). ~\$5100 workers gift was distributed to 4 called workers (~\$1275 ea.). In good shape for the calendar year, ~+\$12,000. Copies of the fourth quarter and year end reports for the Voters were shared.

Pastor's Report

• Nothing to report.

Board of Elders Report

- A short video by Tom Lentz about the CLC Cooperative Budget was viewed. Per the Elders recommendation, motion carried to present a CBP of \$56,000 for 2023 to the Voters. This is a 5.7% increase over last year's amount.
- Lynn Sandhoefner desires to be removed from voter membership.
- Pastor talked about the timing of addressing voter membership requests at Voters' meetings. Plan is to address when pastor presents his report.
- The copy machine is getting to a point where it should be replaced.

Board of Education Report

- James Bomber is willing to serve as the Sunday School Superintendent for the remainder of the year. A new superintendent was needed since David Hein moved to Chicago for his job.
- Motion carried to recommend to the Voters new tuition rates for non-member students for the 2023-24 school year. Rates as follows:
 - \$1500 for kindergarten
 - For grades 1-8: \$2550 1st child in family; \$2350 2nd child in family;
 \$2100 3rd child in family; \$1950 4th child family
- Janelle is having charging issues with her laptop. Recommended that the laptop be replaced. No special approval is required for the purchase; it can be covered by funds in the Board of Education's budget.

Board of Trustees Report

- The dishwasher in the parsonage was replaced.
- A workday is scheduled for the end of January. Will plan to work on pulling wires for additional security cameras on that day.

Other Business

- Benno presented some updates to the offering collection procedures. Some discussion followed. Handbook to be updated.
- Phil talked about the current software programs used by the church –
 Quicken for accounting and a custom Microsoft Access program he
 developed for offering counting. He suggested looking into new software
 specifically for churches. Motion carried to have the chairman form a
 committee to investigate church management software options.
