¹ Hear now what the LORD says: "Arise, plead your case before the mountains, And let the hills hear your voice. ² Hear, O you mountains, the LORD'S complaint, And you strong foundations of the earth; For the LORD has a complaint against His people, And He will contend with Israel. ³ "O My people, what have I done to you? And how have I wearied you?
