- U. Wales' confirmation is scheduled for Sun., May 21.
- Pastor is scheduled to begin radiation treatment beginning this Thursday.
 The treatment may affect his voice.

Board of Elders' Report

- MN Delegate Conference will be held at Berea on June 10.
- Motion approved to invite the MN Delegate Conference to hold its 2024 meeting at Grace, pending Dorcas Guild ability to serve food.

Board of Education Report

- Iowa Basics tests were conducted. Students performed well on the tests.
- Field Day will be held on May 12 at Inver Grove Hts. for Grades 5-8.
- The spring play will be presented on May 25 and close of year on May 26.
- The Spring Lake Park Tower Days Parade will be on Thur., June 8.
- Motion was made and supported to have a special voters' meeting to decide
 if the congregation will call a third full-time teacher. After much discussion
 both in favor and against the motion, the vote on the motion was 4 voting for
 and 5 voting against. The motion did not pass.
- A member of the Board of Education said that the Board will prepare a presentation on the topic of school expansion for the July voters' meeting.
