- General Fund April offerings: \$69,521 (Special: \$95) VS disbursements: \$99,106, for a negative cash flow of -\$29,585, increasing the deficit to -\$187,661.: Not only large gifts are special, but even small gifts can be special, as the Lord noted of the poor widow's gift of 2 mites: "she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood" (Mar 12:44) "Truly, I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all of them. (Luke 21:3) He speaks to the "heart" of giving, whether gifts are small or large. And He speaks to our deficit concerns: "God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work." (2Cor 9:8) Perhaps the Lord may cover the deficit with an outpouring of His abundant grace on members in May & June to bring their special offerings, large & small. Perhaps He may cover our deficit with the CLC Reserve of His previous abundant grace. No matter, "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not, with Him, also, freely give us all things?" (Rom 8:32)
- **CLC Reserve Fund** is held in our Investment Pool account to grow until needed, typically at the end of the fiscal year June 30. The April Investment balance was \$1,227, due to investment capital gains for April. Div/Int income received since last July: \$10,972.
- **ILC Operations April** revenue: **\$118,741** (incl. \$50,739, Tuition/R&B/Fees; \$63,810 General Fund subsidy) **VS** disbursements: **\$122,942** (incl. \$78,224 wages; \$13,500 Food Service; \$3,010, Bldgs/ Ground/Utilities; \$717, Admin. Annual ILC Budget: \$1,552,000.
- IIF April receipts: \$35,436 (\$2,453/mo bequest; \$365 offerings, \$32,620, hail insurance) VS \$117,912 covered hail repairs. The Pool IIF balance is in the checking acct for summer repairs.
- **ILC Bldg April** receipts: **\$4,383**; (\$2,453 monthly bequest; \$1,930 offerings) **VS** disbursed: **\$0** Div/Int income received since last July: \$48,714.
- **CEF- April** receipts:**\$23,301** (\$22,761 loan payments on P&I; \$540 gifts)**VS** disbursed: **\$37,400** (Debt service & Member Notes repaid, and admin \$4,106). Div/Int income received since July: \$99,241.
- MDF April receipts: \$8,745 (Offerings) VS disbursed \$42,128 (\$1,730 Admin; \$1,450 Exploratory; \$10,105 3rd Missionary salary, CLC retirement & travel.
- **SAF-April** Rcpts:**\$7,196** (\$6,090, Loan pmts; \$1,106 gifts)**VS** Disb:**\$6,487** (\$5,495 Grants, Loans) Div/Int income since last July: <u>SAF</u>: \$54,870; <u>PMP</u>: (Pastor/Teacher Prep): \$64,910; <u>Scholarship</u>: \$4,318.
- **Kinship April** receipts: **\$12,641**: (\$5,566 offerings, \$7,075 sponsors) **VS** disbursed: **\$54,300** (\$34,000 disaster relief; 948, Admin; \$10,700 Orphanages;\$8,675, Seminary students; \$90 widows).
