Council Meeting Notes – June 11, 2023

Meeting opened with prayer. May Council meeting minutes were read, edited and approved. May Treasurer's Report was presented and approved.

Pastor's Report

- Uriah Wales confirmed May 21. Motion approved to recommend to Voters that we ratify Uriah Wales into communicant membership.
- The Minnesota Delegate Conference accepted Grace's offer to host the Joint Reformation Service to be held on Oct. 29 at 4 pm.
- The Minnesota Delegate Conference also accepted Grace's offer to host the June 8, 2024, delegate conference (10 am through late afternoon).
- Pastor completed radiation treatments last week. The treatment has helped to reduce pain, but has caused increased fatigue. He will be having more scans with possible treatment to follow.

Board of Elders' Report

- The Board of Elders presented a Draft Policy regarding Gifts or Non-Wage Disbursements. Several edits were suggested. Motion approved to incorporate the policy into the Grace Handbook with the suggested edits.
- The Board of Elders presented an Expense Reimbursement Policy for Pastor. Motion approved to incorporate the policy into the Grace Handbook.

Board of Education Report

- Spring Lake Park Tower Days parade was a success. Thank you to Dave Rust for the use of his truck, to Rick Nelson for all that he did, and to all the volunteers that helped. Janelle got an email the same evening with interest in the school and VBS.
- The Board of Ed presented a plan to ease upper grade schoolroom over-crowding. The board believes that adding a third full-time teacher is the best way to resolve the issue, but as an interim step adding a part-time kindergarten teacher would help. There was much discussion. One counterproposal was to eliminate kindergarten. Another idea was to split the grades into k-4 and 5-8. The board believes that these options would be difficult to implement and would degrade the education offered at Grace. Motion approved to call a special Voters' meeting to consider the proposal to add a new part-time Kindergarten teacher with a budget amendment for approximately \$15,000 for the remainder of 2023 so that we may extend a call. The president asked the pastor to send a notice for a special voters' meeting to be held on June 25.

Board of Trustees' Report

- The clothes washer in the parsonage overflowed. The washer has been fixed.
- The church water heater, discussed last month, has been flushed.
- Grace received a letter concerning the Employee Retention Credit. There are some CLC members in Eau Claire who have experience with this and should be able to help us with it. The board will contact them for help.

Other Business

- The Grace church Home Depot credit card is in Benno's name. He has been issued a new card. He will get 4 cards to give to the people that need it.
- Motion approved to remove the Wells Fargo savings accounts, moving the money to the Fidelity money market account.
- Motion approved to eliminate the two CLC CEF demand notes, moving the money to the Fidelity money market account.
- Motion approved to pursue the purchase of a church management service at a cost of about \$150 per month.

CALLING ON GOD FOR HELP

"Call on me in times of trouble. I will rescue you, and you will honor me.'" Psalm 50:15

This passage describes the life of faithful believers. All of the misfortunes we experience are nothing but a joyful game God plays with us. Sometimes a father will tell his little child to do something even though he knows the child isn't strong enough, or the task is too difficult. He may tell his little son to bring him a bucket or to take off his socks or boots. When the child tries hard to accomplish the task, even though it's much too hard for him, the father will gladly and quickly lend a hand. He will praise his child for his efforts. This will train the child to obey, and the child will also learn to love his father more and more.

These are the kinds of games that God plays with the God-fearing and faithful people who are his children and who call him Father. They don't doubt his fatherly love and good intentions in the least. They experience his tenderness firsthand when he reaches down to them and helps them in a fatherly way. God will be pleased with their efforts and will praise everything they do—even if it's small and weak. This is very similar to the way an earthly father appreciates and praises the efforts of his little children when they try to complete a task that is much too difficult for them.
