Media and police came to assess the situation. The estimated repairs will cost around \$2,500, which is beyond the ability of the CLCI to pay. The mission board has approved \$2,500 to rebuild the wall, which is needed to provide security for the seminary classes and the orphans living there. <u>Voters Meeting Notes – June 25, 2023</u>

Meeting opened with prayer. This special meeting was called by President Eli Wales to consider a proposal from the Council. The Board of Education described the organization of the Christian Day school. They also described the need for adding a part-time kindergarten teacher. They presented an estimation of the costs associated with adding a part-time kindergarten teacher.

A motion was adopted to add a 60% part-time time kindergarten teacher and to add \$15k to the FY23 Board of Education budget.

After much discussion for and against the motion, a motion to split the motion into two parts was supported and passed.

The motion to add 60% part-time kindergarten teacher was supported and passed in a ballot vote.

The motion to have a budget amendment adding \$15k for the remainder of 2023 was supported and passed in a ballot vote.

A motion was adopted by unanimous vote to extend a part time call at 60% to Levi Schaller to be our kindergarten teacher beginning in the 2023-24 school year.

The Voters prayed to the Lord with regard to this call.
