²⁰ So it came to pass in the process of time that Hannah conceived and bore a son, and called his name Samuel, *saying*, "Because I have asked for him from the LORD." ²¹ Now the man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice and his vow. ²² But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, "*Not* until the child is weaned; then I will take him, that he may appear before the LORD and remain there forever." ²³ And Elkanah her husband said to her, "Do what seems best to you; wait until you have weaned him. Only let the LORD establish His word." So the woman stayed and nursed her son until she had weaned him. ²⁴ Now when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bulls, one ephah of flour, and a skin of wine, and brought him to the house of the LORD in Shiloh. And the child *was* young. ²⁵ Then they slaughtered a bull, and brought the child to Eli. ²⁶ And she said, "O my lord! As your soul lives, my lord, I *am* the woman who stood by you here, praying to the LORD. ²⁷ "For this child I prayed, and the LORD has granted me my petition which I asked of Him. ²⁸ "Therefore I also have lent him to the LORD; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the LORD." - P: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.
- C: And also with you.
- P: Our Savior Jesus Christ commanded baptism when He said, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." All of us are born into this world with a deep need for baptism. From our parents we inherit a sinful nature; we are without true fear of God and true faith in God and are condemned to eternal death. But Jesus took away our sin by giving His life on the cross. Through our baptism He clothes us with the robe of His righteousness and gives us a new life. Our sinful nature need not control us any longer. We recall what baptism means for our daily lives as we speak these words:
- C: Baptism means that the old Adam in us should be drowned by daily contrition and repentance and die with all sins and evil desires. It also means that a new Man should daily appear and arise, who lives eternally before God in righteousness and purity.

Sing: Baptized into Thy name most holy,
O Father, Son, and Holy Ghost,

I claim a place, though weak and lowly, Among Thy seed, Thy chosen host,

Buried with Christ and dead to sin.
Thy Spirit now shall live within. (TLH 298, st. 1)

- P: As baptized children of God we confess our sins:
- C: Holy and merciful Father, I confess that I am by nature sinful, and that I have disobeyed You in my desires, thoughts, words, and actions. I have done what is evil and failed to do what is good. For this I deserve Your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior Jesus Christ, I pray: Lord, be merciful to me, a sinner.
- P: God, our Heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given His only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.

P: Let us respond in thanksgiving and praise!

Sing: For the joy Thine advent gave me,

For Thy holy, precious Word;

For Thy Baptism, which doth save me, For Thy blest Communion board; For Thy death, the bitter scorn, For Thy resurrection mourn,

Lord, I thank Thee and extol Thee,

P: What do we confess about the meaning and power of Baptism?

C: Baptism is not just plain water. It is water used by God's command and connected with God's Word. ... Baptism works the forgiveness of sins, delivers from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe, as the words and promises of God declare. ... The water doesn't actually do anything by itself. The power is in God's word, which is in and with the water, and in faith which trusts this word of God in the water. Without the word of God it is just plain water, and there is no baptism. But with the word of God it really is a baptism, that is, a gracious water of life and washing of rebirth through the Holy Spirit.
