## Council Meeting Notes – September 10, 2023

Meeting opened with prayer. August Council meeting minutes read and approved. August Treasurer's Report was presented and approved.

#### Pastor's Report

- Motion approved to recommend to the voters that Dan Kelly be accepted as communicant member based on his baptism and profession of faith.
- Confirmation class has resumed.
- Sunday school staff has been installed, and reminder of background checks.
- The MN Joint Reformation service will be held at Grace, Oct. 29, 4 pm. Pastor has asked Pastor Ted Barthels to preach at that service.
- A draft of the 2024 Grace calendar was presented.
- Pastor is hoping to go to Liberia in January.

#### **Board of Elders' Report**

- Church picnic is planned for next week. Elders plan to cook hot dogs.
- The Elders are not planning to implement an HRA at this time because of possible negative impact on Pastor's insurance. They still plan to investigate HRA accounts in the future.

#### **Board of Education Report**

- The 2023-24 school year began on Aug. 28 with 23 students.
- Parents' night is planned for Sept. 25.
- Field trip is planned to Wargo Nature Center's Heritage Lab on Sept. 29.

#### **Board of Trustees' Report**

• The trustees fixed a leaking faucet in the Kindergarten, north classroom, and also repaired some ceiling stains.

#### Other Business

- There have been positive comments about the recent sanctuary improvements. Painting of the sanctuary walls is complete. There are plans to paint the narthex and parents room. The committee hopes to get a quote for new carpet for both the sanctuary (minus the altar area) and the narthex. Motion approved to get carpet for both sanctuary and narthex.
- One of the current sanctuary light fixtures was updated for improved lighting, but doing that update was quite labor-intensive. The committee has concluded that modifying the current fixtures is not practical. A new approach to lighting the sanctuary will be investigated after carpeting.
- People have made positive comments about the stained board samples that have been put in the sanctuary in place of crown molding. Motion approved to install stained 4" board molding rather than painted crown molding approve in the sanctuary.
- The Realm contribution and accounting system was presented and demonstrated. There is a two-sided instruction sheet for the counters.
- There was some discussion about the makeup of counting teams.
- The Gusto payroll system is online for the Sept. 15 payroll.
