#### **CLC Financial Report - October**

**General Fund – October** receipts: **\$83,849 VS** disbursements: **\$89,726**. The General Fund budget is funded by our "Cooperative Budget Plan" (CBP) offerings to subsidize the work of the Boards of Missions, Trustees, EdPub, & Regents (including ILC.) These are sometimes also referred to as "CLC Mission offerings."

ILC Operations - October receipts: \$115,806 VS disbursements: \$134,936.

IIF – October receipts: \$2,779 VS disbursements: \$2,827.

- **ILC Building October** receipts: **\$80,166**; (\$107,614 offerings including an extra offering of \$100,000 offset by a \$27,448 decrease in market value of investments) **VS** disbursements: **None**.
- **MDF October** receipts: **\$10,849 VS** disbursements: **\$15,111.** The balance in this fund is less than half of what it was a year ago. In addition to the many projects for which it has budgeted, this year it is also covering the entire cost of the third foreign missionary.
- Kinship October receipts: \$6,763: VS disbursements: \$1,200.

**CEF** – **October** receipts: **\$317,890** (including a congregational loan payoff) **VS** disbursements: **\$254,185** (including a congregational loan of \$250,000).

SAF – October receipts: \$6,564 VS disbursements: \$12,070.

**Reserve Fund** is invested in interest/dividend-bearing accounts until needed, typically each fiscal year-end. The YTD Revenue of negative \$2,343 reflects the decrease in market value since July 1.

EduK8 Fund – October receipts: \$680. Balance \$34,605.
