General Fund – February receipts: **\$69,641 VS** disbursements: **\$80,141.** The General Fund subsidizes the work of the Boards of Missions, Trustees, EdPub, & Regents (including ILC.)

ILC Operations – February receipts: \$164,264 VS disbursements: \$126,813.

IIF – February receipts: \$2,858 VS disbursements: None.

ILC Building Projects – February receipts: **\$9,405** (including a \$5,076 increase in market value of investments) **VS** disbursements: **None**.

MDF – February receipts: \$11,604 VS disbursements: \$10,678.

Kinship - February receipts: \$29,175 VS disbursements: \$2,448.

CEF – February receipts: **\$34,642** (including a \$14,391 increase in market value of investments) **VS** disbursements: **\$79,913** (mostly payments on member loans to the CEF).

SAF – February receipts: **\$6,098 VS d**isbursements: **\$10,510** (including student loans, grants, scholarships and tuition assistance).

Reserve Fund is currently invested in a money market account until needed, typically each fiscal year-end.
