<sup>20</sup>Then the multitude came together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread. <sup>21</sup>But when His own people heard *about this*, they went out to lay hold of Him, for they said, "He is out of His mind." <sup>22</sup>And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beelzebub," and, "By the ruler of the demons He casts out demons." <sup>23</sup>So He called them to *Himself* and said to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? <sup>24</sup>"If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. <sup>25</sup>"And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. <sup>26</sup>"And if Satan has risen up against himself, and is divided, he cannot stand, but has an end. <sup>27</sup>"No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. And then he will plunder his house. <sup>28</sup>"Assuredly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they may utter; <sup>29</sup>"but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is subject to eternal condemnation" -- <sup>30</sup>because they said, "He has an unclean spirit." <sup>31</sup>Then His brothers and His mother came, and standing outside they sent to Him, calling Him. <sup>32</sup>And a multitude was sitting around Him; and they said to Him, "Look, Your mother and Your brothers are outside seeking You." <sup>33</sup>But He answered them, saying, "Who is My mother, or My brothers?" <sup>34</sup>And He looked around in a circle at those who sat about Him, and said, "Here are My mother and My brothers! <sup>35</sup>"For whoever does the will of God is My brother and My sister and mother." 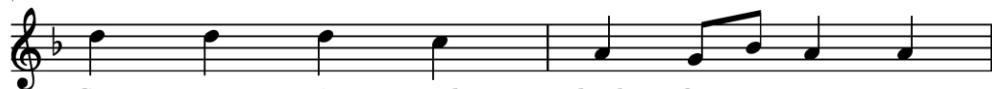
