Voter Meeting Notes – July 14, 2024

Meeting opened with prayer. June Council meeting minutes were read and approved. June Treasurer's report was reviewed and approved.

Pastor's Report

• There was no pastor's report. He will update next month.

Board of Elders' Report

• Rick has the invoice ready for the shirts that were made for the church. That invoice will be paid from the Elders' budget.

Board of Education Report

- \$33,350 in non-member tuition was received in the 2023-24 school year.
- Background checks and training for staff will be updated and documented.
- Grace handbook ILHS tuition payment wording needs to be updated to state that Grace will pay "up to" 100% of ILHS student tuition.
- Kevin suggested and the consensus agreed that Pastor put information in the bulletin about the Tuition Aid Fund, including the ILHS tuition cost and the number of Grace members attending ILHS this year.
- The kindergarten teacher would like to have kindergarten t-shirts. Laura will work with Rick to get the t-shirts.

Board of Trustees' Report

- Work has begun on the lilacs. Llilacs larger than 2 inches in diameter have been removed. About 66% of work is done. The workday on July 27 should complete this task. This process will be repeated next year to remove lilacs larger than 1 ½ inch. About five truckloads of brush were removed.
- Weeds in the yard have been sprayed.

Other Business

- The sanctuary committee will present the results of the altar survey at the July Voters' meeting. Removing the sections of the altar in stages has been helpful. Thanks to Jeff for making the cross. The electronic survey had not been sent to the congregation. The council would like to send that to the congregation early this week so that we can get as many survey responses before the voters' meeting as possible.
- There will be a presentation to the Voters next week, proposing that Grace offer the ability to make online contributions. The cost will be 2-2.5% of related contributions. Benno thinks that use of online giving will simplify things both for the contributors and the counters. Rick and Brian both think that the process of preparing a weekly contribution is beneficial and that something is lost when contribution is put on auto-pay.
- Benno thinks we need to get another person to help with the Realm system.
- There was a discussion about the best way to support the Pastor and Janelle fulfill their calls. The Elders are encouraged to discuss this with Pastor Hein.
