For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body-- whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free-- and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. ¹⁴ For in fact the body is not one member but many. ¹⁵ If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body? 16 And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body? 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where would be the smelling? 18 But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased. ¹⁹ And if they were all one member, where *would* the body *be*? ²⁰ But now indeed there are many members, yet one body. ²¹ And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." ... ²⁶ And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. ²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. $(NKJV^{TM})$

- The Melvin Eichstadt funeral was held on December 16.
- Midweek Lenten services begin March 6.
- Daniel Hein has been added to the list of communion servers, and he may also assist in some other parts of services.
- Pastor Hein thanks those that have helped including Kevin Hulke, Rev. Fleischer, Rev. Schierenbeck, and others in the congregation.
- The called workers appreciate the Christmas gift and the opportunity to serve.
- Pastor read highlights from his 2024 Ministrations Report.
- Attendance has been steady.
- Other statistics and the calendar in the report were also presented.

Board of Elders' Report

- 10 new hymnals from Messiah in Eau Claire are being purchased for use by the choir and members interested in checking them out. The hymnals are \$20 each.

- This is an average of \$2,815 per communicant.
- A total of 56 envelopes were used out of 80 assigned.
- 58% of offerings were from 10 families (8 of whom are retired).
- 83% of offerings were from 20 families.
- Kevin reported that online giving is now open to anyone that wants to use it.
 Online giving reporting might not be included in the bulletin every week. We thank Benno for the work he has done. The Council is considering how to cover the work Benno has done. Thanks also to Phil who has also worked on these things.
- The Sanctuary committee is in the process of developing a 3rd rendering of the altar area. Rick and Larry removed the cushion from one front pew, and will meet with a person to get a replacement cushion.
- Cooperative Budget: A presentation on CLC finances was projected. The Grace CBP estimate was \$56,000 in 2023 and \$59,020 in 2024. Recommended motion from the Council was approved to set \$60,000 as the Grace 2025 CBP estimate.
