The FISH



When Peter and Andrew were called to be disciples by our Savior, He told them: "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." This truth stands for us as well. When our Savior commissioned His apostles, He included us, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations ..." We have been commissioned to be fishers of men - to be missionaries. Having been called by the Gospel of Christ, it is now our task to make our Savior's redeeming work made known in the world. From time to time we may hear the saying, "There are plenty of fish in the sea." This is certainly true when we contemplate how many people in this world are in need of the Gospel of Christ.

That is just part of the meaning of the fish symbol. It does have a deeper meaning. During the early years of Christianity, there were Roman emperors who allowed persecution of Christians. Many were killed for sake of their confession of Christ. So in order to avoid being martyred, the Christians would identify themselves to one another by drawing the simple fish sketch in the ground with a stick.

The word you see below in the fish symbol is the Greek word for fish: $\mathbf{IX}\mathbf{\Theta}\mathbf{\Psi}\mathbf{\Sigma}$. Each Greek letter of this word is the first letter of other Greek words:

I: The first letter of Ιησους which in English corresponds to "**Jesus**"

X: The first letter of Xριστος which in English corresponds to "Christ"

Θ : The first letter of Θεος which in English corresponds to "God"

 Ψ : The first letter of $\Psi \upsilon \iota \circ \varsigma$ which in English corresponds to "Son of"

 Σ : The first letter of Σ ωτηρ which in English corresponds to "Savior"

So the Greek word for fish actually was an abbreviation for the following confession: Jesus Christ, Son of God, is Savior.
