¹ Now when they drew near Jerusalem, and came to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, ² saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to Me. ³ "And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saving: 5 "Tell the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey."⁶ So the disciples went and did as Jesus commanded them.⁷ They brought the donkey and the colt, laid their clothes on them, and set *Him* on them.⁸ And a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road; others cut down branches from the trees and spread them on the road.⁹ Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' Hosanna in the highest!"¹⁰ And when He had come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, "Who is this?" ¹¹ So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee." ¹² Then Jesus went into the temple of God ... ¹⁵ But when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that He did, and the children crying out in the temple and saying, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" they were indignant ¹⁶ and said to Him, "Do You hear what these are saying?" And Jesus said to them, "Yes. Have you never read, 'Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have perfected praise'?" ¹⁷ Then He left them and went out of the city to Bethany, and He lodged there. (*NKJVTM*)

- Myanmar: It was reported this week that a civil war battle broke out in the area where some of our fellow Christians lived. Seven houses belonging to our CLCM church members were burned down. The people had to scatter to the nearest village and forest for safety. "The Lord is faithful and His mercy and grace are sufficient to those who believe in Christ Jesus. Thank you for your prayer, comfort, and encouragement to strengthen in the Lord. Amen. In Christ, Kham CLCM"
- Persecution in India: This Tuesday afternoon two CLCI pastors were returning for church when they were stopped and dragged from their motorcycle by 6 masked men and beaten. One suffered a few scratches and broken teeth. Another, however, was beaten severely

with wooden sticks. They stole the motorcycle while telling them to stop evangelizing. The pastors went to the hospital where one had to have surgery on his nose and for his three front broken teeth. The other had to have root canals. They filed a police report but since the men were masked and there were no witness the police are unable to do much. They have yet to recover the motorcycle. A pastor not in our fellowship was recently killed 50 miles from this area, probably by the same group that attacked our men. On March 19 a CLCI preaching station was attacked by a group of Hindu extremists who stopped the service and demanded to see a worship permit. The pastor and members went to the police who told the pastor to stop leading the church and ordered him to meet with the police superintendent. Recently 50 people stopped another CLCI Sunday worship service in a different area and ordered the pastor and believers to stop the service or move to another village. Please pray for our CLCI brothers and sisters as they are facing more and more persecution in a supposedly secular and free country. While these attacks are illegal, it is difficult to get justice from a predominantly Hindu police force. (adapted from Missionary Peter Evensen)

Confession and Absolution:

- <u>P</u>: On Palm Sunday, the crowds entering Jerusalem waved their palm branches and worshiped Jesus as the King who comes in the name of the Lord. On Good Friday, the crowds in Jerusalem rejected Jesus as their King and called for His crucifixion. On Pentecost, the crowds in Jerusalem were cut to the heart to hear from Peter that they had crucified the Lord of Glory. As we worship King Jesus today, let us flee to the Lord for mercy, humbly confessing our sin and guilt that caused His death on Good Friday.
- <u>C</u>: Hosanna, Son of David, Son of God. Lord, save us. We need Your salvation for we are sinful by nature and have sinned against God. We have dishonored God with our sinful thoughts, sinful words, and sinful actions. All too quickly our lips go from praise to grumbling, from blessing to cursing. Not our palms, or praises, or anything we lay before You can make up or atone for our sins. Yet you come to us in the Name of the Lord, to be our Merciful Savior. You alone can save, must save, or we perish. Save now, Jesus, Savior, Christ our King.
- <u>P</u>: Zephaniah 3:14-17: "Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! The LORD has taken away your judgments, He has cast out your enemy. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in your midst; You shall see disaster no more. ... 'Do

not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

<u>P</u>: May the LORD your God quiet you with His love, confident that Jesus rode into Jerusalem to die to take away the judgments against you, to clear away your enemies of death and hell, and forgive your sins. Cleansed from your sins by the blood of Christ, the LORD now sings with joy over you. Amen. Let us now sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel for Jesus comes with forgiveness.

General Fund and ILC Operations – The combined balance of these two operating funds is down about \$62,000 compared to the same time one year ago. Contributions to and disbursements from the General Fund are well below budget for the first nine months of our fiscal year. For ILC Operations, the revenue is ahead of budget with disbursements less than the pro-rated budget.

ILC Building Projects - Year-to-date contributions have been about \$240,000. The remaining vear-to-date revenue of around \$112,000 is from increases in the market value of the investments in this fund.

Church Extension Fund – Year to date revenue consists of payments received of about \$222,000 from congregations on the loans they owe the CLC, just over \$186,000 of increases in the market value of the investments and just over \$1,000 of contributions to the fund.

EduK8 Fund – The fund had its 1st disbursement (\$3,500) to assist one of our Christian Day Schools.

Other Auxiliary Funds – The activity in the other funds in the table above is similar to the activity in the same period a year ago.


