Council Meeting Notes – November 9, 2025

Meeting opened w/prayer. Motion approved the October Council meeting minutes. Motion approved the October Treasurer's report.

Pastor's Report

- Instruction class with Max Milbrandt is continuing.
- There have been several visitors attending services recently.
- Pastor Pfeiffer will conduct the Thanksgiving Eve service at Grace.
- Advent midweek and Christmas services have been planned.

Board of Elders' Report

- Motion approved to set the 2026 Account Reimbursement to \$4,800.
- Motion approved to set the 2026 Parsonage Exclusion to \$2,400.
- Potentially Pastor could be gone for a CAR-T study at NIH from around Dec.
 29 to about Feb. 4. Pastor and the Elders are planning on coverage.

Board of Education Report

- \$1,244 in tuition was received during October which means that \$6,974 of \$43,044 for 2025-2026 school year has been received.
- Ellen helped Jan substitute while Janelle was with Pastor at NIH.
- Janelle is working on subbing from Jan. 5 to Feb. 6 while she may be at NIH.
- Janelle offered to decline her salary while she is gone. Pastor also expressed the same. Grace has not withheld salaries in the past. The council agreed that we should continue salary payment as we have done in the past.

Board of Trustees' Report

• Motion approved to contract with an exterminator to deal with the mice problem.

Other Business

- Renewal of the church insurance with Church Mutual was discussed because
 of the increased premium. Agreement that it would be good to consider
 getting insurance from a new insurer. There was also agreement we have
 had good experience with Church Mutual. There was agreement that we
 should renew our insurance through Church Mutual, but also investigate
 changing insurance providers in the future.
- Phil gave a report on the Minnesota Paid Leave law. A sheet explaining the plan is posted on the bulletin board in the copier room. There was a discussion about the ability of Grace to opt out of the program. Phil will investigate the ability of Grace to opt out of the program. The cost to Grace would currently be about \$1,200 annually. Motion approved that in the event that Grace does not opt out of the program, Grace pay the premium for participation in the Minnesota Paid Leave program.
- There has been a question asking if we can have a member of the Dorcas guild enter personal information into the Realm system.
- Motion approved to ask the Dorcas guild to maintain name and address information in Realm was supported and approved by unanimous vote.
- The nomination committee plans to meet after service Nov 16.
- Phil is talking with Brandon about replacing eight Windows 10 computers and two servers. He will report when more information is available.
- Dale asked if we want to transfer more funds from checking to Fidelity and to pursue higher return investments for our reserve accounts. Phil suggested that we form a policy for investment.
- Motion approved that the Trustees bring a cost estimate to the January Voters' meeting for putting up a 6-foot fence around the rest of the playground ending within 10 ft. of the church driveway.
